Current 2L & 3L J.D. students are invited to submit coursework (10,000 words max.) related to International Justice and Human Rights. The selected candidate will receive a \$500 scholarship.**



Donald Sorochan, Q.C., is an invaluable member of the legal community. He is a founding director of the Justice Institute of British Columbia, the International Society for the Reform of Criminal Law (ISRCL), and the International Centre for Criminal Law Reform and Criminal Justice Policy (ICCLR). He was also appointed by the Attorney General of B.C. to establish the B.C. International Commercial Arbitration Centre. He acted as lead counsel in several provincial and federal inquiries and Royal Commissions and represented the CBA to redraft the Criminal Code of Canada.

This award has been established in Donald Sorochan's name in recognition of his many achievements to law and justice, nationally and internationally, and for the invaluable support he has given to the work and activities of both ISRCL and the ICCLR over the past twenty years.
